 - a. It's all about honoring God
 - b. Response to God

 - c. SO WHAT will you do? (Joshua 24:15)
 - d. Examples of obedience
 - i. Noah (Gen. 7:5—"And Noah did all that the Lord commanded him."
 - ii. Abram
 - iii. Moses (Ex. 4:3,6,20)
 - iv. Paul & Barnabas
 - e. Obedience at LEFC

f. OBEDIENCE IS A LIFESTYLE, NOT AN ISOLATED ACT.
