Sermon Notes September 17, 2017

Disciple-making paradigm:

- 1. You love on someone.
- 2. Your love and passion for other displayed to them.
- 3. Invitation to participate with you.
- 4. Their heart is won over—a disciple is made.

Paradigm proven effective:

- I love...
- My son loves...

Living like Jesus is loving Jesus. Matthew 25:31-40

- The church as reflected in society has both sheep and goats. (32)
- There will be a time where the shepherd will identify and gather his sheep.
- Their heart reflecting what was upon his heart identified his sheep.
 - Meeting the physical needs (hunger and thirst) of those around them—compassion to the needy. (35a)
 - Jesus' example: feeding five thousand.
 - Offering hospitality to a stranger in need of community. (35b)
 - Jesus' example: inviting Zachaeus and Matthew to the dinner table.
 - o Providing clothes when needed. (36a)
 - Jesus taught that being generous was going even to the second coat.
 - Meeting the needs of a sick person. (36b)
 - Jesus did this so many times by being with the family and the sick person.
 - o Minister to those in bondage or prison. (36c)
 - Jesus released those who were literal prisoners—even Barabbas, and those who were in spiritual or demonic bondage.

- Doing these acts of compassion and love ties you so intrinsically to the heart of Jesus that it was how you expressed your love to him. (37-40)
- To not behave in this manner says you really don't know or love Jesus. (41-46)

Vision leads.

- 1. Loving Jesus comes first.
- 2. You become a master of understanding and knowing what makes Jesus tick.
- 3. Your love for him causes you to have a vision for life that is filled with compassion and love for others.
- 4. As a result, both Jesus and those who are around you know that you are a follower of Christ—a disciple!
- 5. REPEAT with another!
