# **Session I: Tony Sabbatical Debrief**

Tony shared photos from his Israel trip with the elders, as well as other highlights from his sabbatical. His personal study in the Old Testament had grown his desire to go to Israel, and he is excited for how it will enhance his teaching now that he has been there.

#### **Session II Part 1: LEFC Ministry Vision**

During his sabbatical, Tony visited other area churches that are similar or slightly larger in size.

Tony summarized by saying that he feels we have a unique place in Northern Lancaster County as a modern worship service with a strong bible teaching emphasis. Generally, it's tough to excel with both worship and preaching but we have a special balance. Our people have energy and joy in worship, with an atmosphere of vitality and authenticity. We hold scripture as the authority in our teaching, and teach on a personal relationship with God. We continue to saturate the vision of missional living among our people in their Oikos. Our calling is to not be satisfied with the 99, and to have the heart of Christ; we want to grow grass not steal sheep.

## **Session III: Project Open Invitation Update**

Joel presented the final construction plans, pricing vs budget, cost reduction options and available contingency, schedule sequence and logistics for discussion and decision. Tony reviewed upcoming plans for the campaign re-launch and vision re-cast. We will discuss plans for presentation to the membership at the November meeting. Four-Week Mini-Campaign to be launched on October 14 to provide key updates and communicate a renewed emphasis on the project. This will give an opportunity to pledge more or pledge for the first time.
