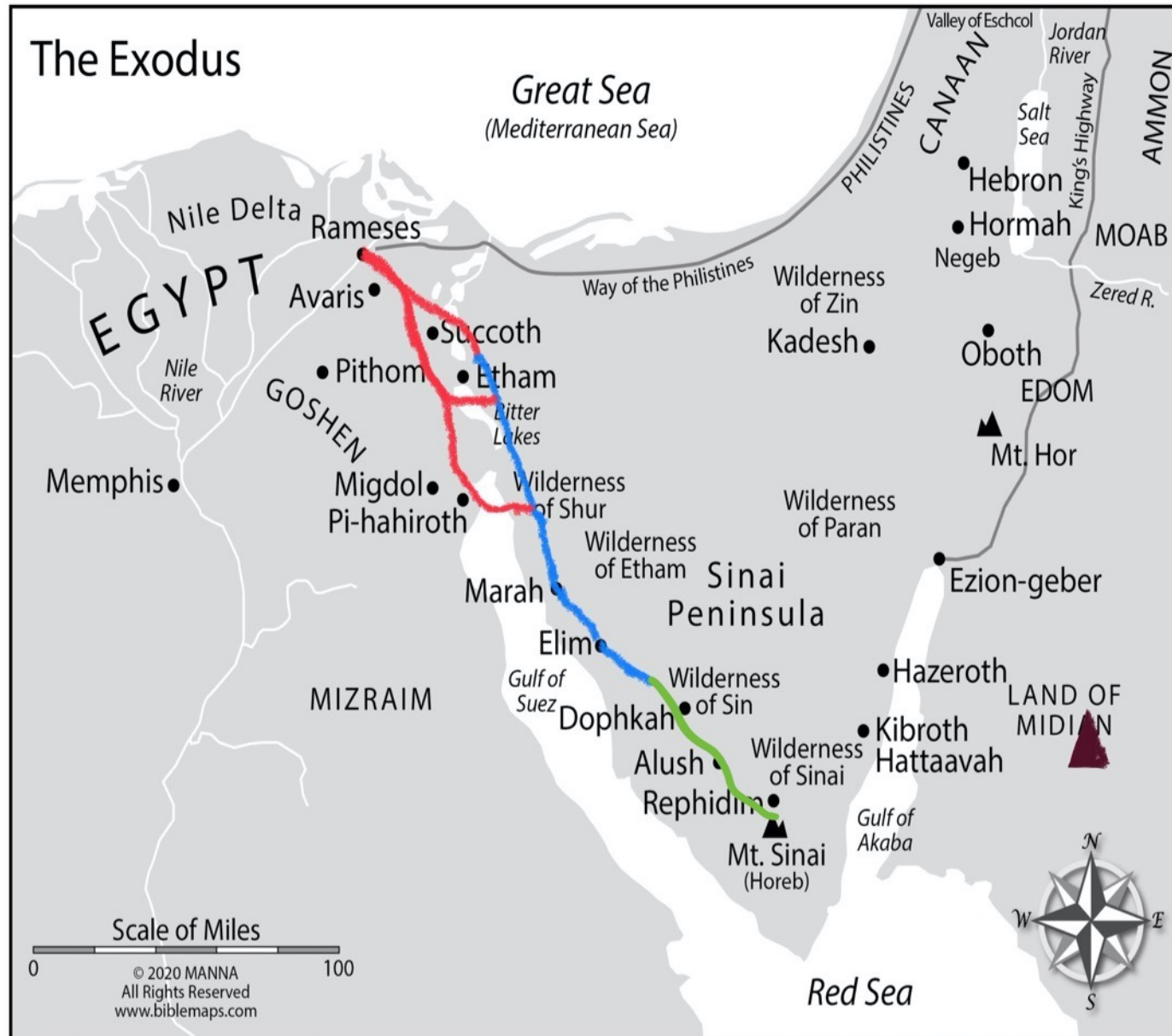

~Exodus 17:7

God bears that judgment and instead extends grace and provision to the people by giving what they need - living water. This is yet another image or foreshadowing of Christ. He bore our judgment and delivered us from spiritual death.



They were delivered through a type of Christ in Moses, receiving the same spiritual food and water as we do today. God offers them water once again, and they are delivered.

Deuteronomy 25:¹⁷ “Remember what Amalek did to you on the way as you came out of Egypt, ¹⁸ how he attacked you on the way when you were faint and weary, and cut off your tail, those who were lagging behind you, and he did not fear God.

19 Therefore when the Lord your God has given you rest from all your enemies around you, in the land that the Lord your God is giving you for an inheritance to possess, you shall blot out the memory of Amalek from under heaven; you shall not forget.

The Egyptians experience God's judgment at the Red Sea, God bears the judgment of Israel's sin at the Rock at Horeb, and the Amalekites experience God's judgment in this battle.

The Israelites had to learn to rely on
God and so do we.
