**SUNDAY'S SERMON // SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 21**  
**EPHESIANS 3:14-21 // POWER IN SPIRIT. POWER IN LOVE.**

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

*Use these questions in your community (family, life group, ABF, etc.) to apply this sermon in your life.*

1. Tony preached from Ephesians 3:14-21 this week. Read that passage aloud and think about the theme of power. Have you ever experienced or seen the power of the Spirit at any points of your life? Share a story of one of those times if you have one.
2. A second major theme of this passage is love, and it is pretty clearly woven together with power. How are power and love intertwined?
3. Paul prays that the Ephesians would be filled with the power of the Spirit in their "inner beings." Your inner being constitutes all that you are. How would a person look and act if they were full of power in their inner being? Would you say that you are?
4. Paul says that power is needed to grasp how wide, long, high, and deep the love of God is for us. That's an incredible love. Think back to past weeks' themes of mystery. How might the love of God be mystery but also reveal mystery?
5. Pray for each other. Pray that you each may be filled fully with the power of the Spirit and through that power you will grasp the love the Father has for you. Pray also that you each would boldly and radically show that love to those in your sphere of influence.
