SUNDAY'S SERMON // SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 7 EPHESIANS 3:1-7 // THE MYSTERY REVEALED

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Use these questions in your community (family, life group, ABF, etc.) to apply this sermon in your life.

1. Read through Ephesians 3:1-7 together. Identify some of the significant repeated words or concepts.
2. Paul uses these few verses as an introduction almost halfway through the book. How does he introduce himself? What roles does he state that he holds? Have these always been descriptive of Paul? Think of his conversion—how have they changed?
3. Why would God keep this truth a mystery? What's the difference between the OT and the NT?
4. As a group, come up with a good definition of the mystery described in Ephesians 3:6.
5. Who in your Oikos needs to have this mystery unpacked for them? Pray for them together as you close out your discussion time.
