SUNDAY'S SERMON // SUNDAY, OCTOBER 17 EPHESIANS 2:8-10 // THE GOOD NEWS IS GIFT NEWS

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FROM DR. ED SCHEUERMAN:

Use these questions in your community (family, life group, ABF, etc.) to apply this sermon in your life.

1. Read the following Scripture passages to start your discussion: Romans 10:14-15; I John 5:11-13; Romans 3:23, 6:23, 5:8, and 10:9-10; John 14:6; Hebrews 4:1-11; Romans 8:29; I Thessalonians 5:24; Ephesians 4:32; James 2:18
2. Share a piece of good news that you received in the past few weeks? How did you hear of that good news? How did you respond to it?
3. How did you first hear of the Good News of salvation through Jesus Christ? How did you respond?
4. When it comes to REST, how has Christ given you rest, either related to salvation or your daily life?
5. Have you ever experienced the joy of sharing the Good News with someone who received it?
6. What keeps a Christian from sharing the Good News with others?
7. If you have received the gift of eternal life through Jesus Christ, how well are you THANKING Him with your life?
8. What can you do THIS WEEK to say, "Thank you?"
