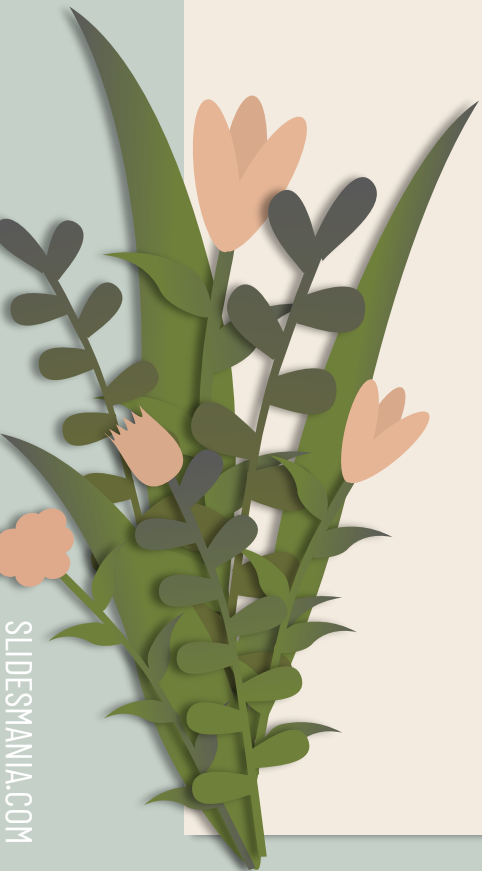


He makes me lie down in green pastures.

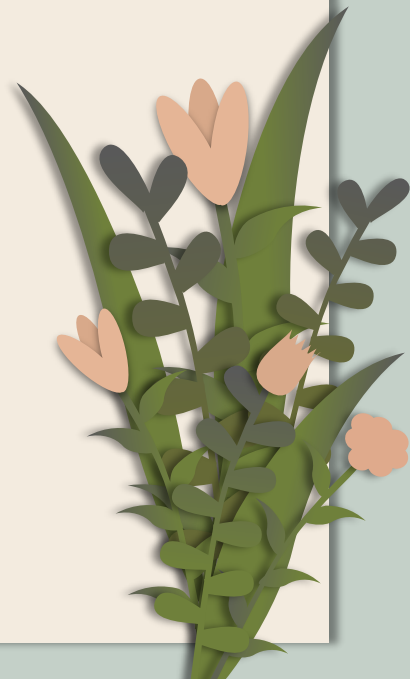
Christ...
