WELCOMED, TRANSFORMED, SENT | April 24, 2022

SERMON RECAP | Acts 4:1-22

Peter's journey was full of ups and downs, great faith, and human weakness, all of which shaped him into a pillar of the early church. Through the story of Peter, we see that God welcomes us, Jesus transforms us, and the Spirit sends us. He's doing the same in your life.

THE LEAD IN

- Within the church, it's easy to put your best face forward, hide your imperfections, and act like a "good" Christian. But it's fake! What are your experiences with church culture? Do you have people with whom you are authentic and show your weaknesses?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Acts 4:1-22. How would you describe Peter and John in this passage? What did they do? How did they act? What happened?
- Read Matthew 14:31, 18:21, 26:41; Mark 8:33; Luke 22:60-62. How is Peter different in these passages than in the Acts 4 passage?

GOING DEEPER

- Can you relate to Peter's journey? Share with the group an example from your story of how you have been transformed by Jesus and are no longer the same as you used to be.
- What is your mission? Are there specific people in your sphere of influence that you feel God prompting you to pursue? Are there causes God is calling you to champion? What are you being led to do that will bring glory to God?

PRAYER

- Pray that you would each continue to be transformed more into the image of Christ and pray for boldness and courage as you are being sent on mission!
