SERMON RECAP | Exodus 20:1-17

The commandment to not covet addresses many types of sin issues, including the previous nine commandments. A content heart leads to godliness but a divided heart leads to a weakening of our relationship with Christ.

THE LEAD IN

• Look back over the first nine commandments. How does coveting play a role in each sin we are to avoid?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Job 31 (v. 1-8 if time is short). Where do you see the connection between our eyes and hearts in this passage? Through the whole passage, look for the sin of coveting and its consequences.
- Using 1 Timothy 6:6-10, compare and contrast contentment with covetousness.

GOING DEEPER

- How have you personally experienced the tie between your eyes and your heart? What do your eyes covet that has settled in your heart? How can gratefulness be a weapon against coveting?
- We began with looking at the issue of coveting running through the commandments. Let's flip that on it's head. How is Jesus revealed through the commandments? How does fixing our eyes on him help us to live rightly under the Law of God?

• Pray for God's strength and help in guarding your heart from covetousness. Fix your eyes on Jesus!
