SERMON RECAP | Matthew 24:23-35

When Jesus returns, there will be no doubt that it is him! But before then, difficult times will deceive desperate people to believe in "false messiahs."

THE LEAD IN

 What have you been taught about the day Jesus returns? What do you think it will be like?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Matthew 24:23-35 has some crazy stuff packed into it! Read the passage and discuss what things we need to be aware of so we aren't deceived.
- Read John 20:24-29. Why do you think Thomas doubted the resurrection? What lesson can we take from the interaction between Jesus and Thomas in our eager waiting for his second coming?
- Revelation 19:11-18 is a picture of what the day will look like that Matthew 24:29-31 alludes to. Also considering Matthew 24:14, why will there be both mourning and joy when these events occur?

GOING DEEPER

 Throughout history, there have been many people who have claimed the end is near and have misled many people, with devastating results. Why is it so easy to be deceived about the end? How do the passages we've read help us live with discernment amidst deception?

PRAYER

Pray for faith for each other as we wait the return of our Savior. Pray that we
would not be deceived by those who act like they are of Christ but are not.
