STEWARDING THE DAY TO DAY | NOVEMBER 20, 2022

SERMON RECAP | Matthew 25:14-30

God has entrusted each of us with belongings to steward until he returns. We are called to be good stewards and will rejoice with the Father when we are with him someday.

THE LEAD IN

- What things/people/skills do you have that you treasure? What means most to you here on earth?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read our main text, Matthew 25:14-30. Why is this parable set within the context of teaching on how to live with expectancy of Jesus' return? We usually read it as a stand-alone teaching on stewardship. Why is the context important?

GOING DEEPER

- Earlier we identified the things we treasure most. Do you trust God with those things? Do you cling to them as yours or are you willing to place them in God's hands. What makes it difficult to "let go"?
- God has entrusted people into our lives and Oikos to share the gospel with. The way we steward those relationships faithfully is by sharing the gospel. As we do this, more will be entrusted to us. Are the unbelievers in your life pushed closer to Christ by being around you? Are you willing to be given more and more gospel opportunities in your Oikos?
- What about the believers in your Oikos? Are you stewarding those relationships well? Are they being pushed towards Christ as a result of their relationship with you?

PRAYER

- Pray that you would each be able to steward well the things God has entrusted to you until he returns.
