

LEFC's mission: To make disciples of Jesus Christ.

Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." - Matthew 28:18–20

The process of making disciples begins with reaching our relational worlds. The Greeks called this group of people their *oikos*. At LEFC we define *oikos* as a group of eight to fifteen people with whom you share life most closely, your sphere of greatest influence.

One of the ways we identify disciples of Jesus Christ is through the marks of a disciple: love, truth, prayer, worship, growth, and outreach. These make up LEFC's core values. As we journey towards becoming mature disciples, we should bear the marks of a disciple in our lives.
